ADHD-Attention

deficit hyper activity

<u>disorder</u>

Often has trouble keeping attention on tasks or play activities.

Often does not seem to listen when spoken to directly.

Often does not follow instructions and fails to finish schoolwork/ activity; moves on to something else.

Often loses things needed for tasks and activities (e.g. toys, school assignments, pencils, books, or tools).

Is often easily distracted. Is often forgetful in daily activities.

Often restless/fidgets with hands or feet or

squirms in seat.

Often gets up from seat when remaining in seat is expected.

Excessive running/ climbing (more than other kids).

Often has trouble playing rule-based games or enjoying leisure activities quietly.

Is often "on the go" or often acts as if "driven by a motor."

Often has trouble waiting one's turn.

Often interrupts or intrudes on others. (pushing/poking/hitti ng...).

Impaired social judgement/ hasty decisions without due thought (older children).
